Beginning this weekend, in addition to our Facebook and YouTube video broadcasts of worship, we are making available a listening channel simply by having you call a toll-free telephone number.

We know that not everyone has access to the Internet to join in a visual way with our worship services. Now you can listen on your phone to our traditional worship services anytime from Sundays at 9:30am throughout the week to the following Sunday prior to the next scheduled service. This capability is available 24 hours a day.

Frequently Asked Questions:

"How do I get the worship service?" You can call **855-400-6434** and you'll be connected to listen on your phone's headset, headphones, bluetooth, or speaker.

"What happens if I call after 9:30am?" You can anytime during the service time or anytime during the week and still hear the whole service. Your phone call recording will always start at the beginning of the service.

"Can I go forward or backwards during the phone call as I listen to the service?" No, you will only be able to listen to the service as if it were "live."

"Why is there a toll-free number?" Some individuals/households have phone plans with a limited number of minutes. Toll-free calls do not add to the minutes that are used in a phone plan. This number is for all callers.

"How long is the service available?" It can be heard until the following Sunday at 9:30am when it will be replaced by the current worship service.

Please pass this information on to anyone you know who may not get this announcement. Besides family and friends, perhaps you can reach out to a fellow neighbor, worker, and others!

What is most important is that you stay safe and healthy, following the guidelines given to us by the government and health officials. To that end, outlined below is what Trinity is doing to help ensure we follow government guidelines as well as keep you connected.

- The **church office will be open every weekday from 9am-3pm** if you should have any questions or need assistance in some way.
- If you go to Trinity's Facebook page to view the worship service(s), you will have the ability to "click" on the live feed button and view the service. There will also be the opportunity to see who else is viewing the service and make comments.
- Both services will be available later in the day to view on Facebook and YouTube.

Please remember that our church and day school depend on your offerings to continue God's work.
