TRINITY'S HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

HEALTH EXAMINATION FORMS: A HEALTH EXAMINATION FORM (INCLUDING PROOF OF HAVING RECEIVED REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS WHICH ARE MEDICALLY POSSIBLE TO RECEIVE) **MUST BE** IN THE SCHOOL OFFICE BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL OR YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND SCHOOL UNTIL RECEIVED.

Q-WHO NEEDS a completed physical examination (including immunization record)?

A-Students entering the following grades:

- 3-YEAR OLD PRESCHOOL
- 4-YEAR OLD PRE-KINDERGARTEN
- KINDERGARTEN
- GRADE 6
- All students moving into Illinois from another state.

****Transfer Students**: A Health Examination form must be included with your child's school/health records. If it is not received by October 1, a copy must be provided by the student's guardian or the child will not be allowed to attend until it is received.

DENTAL EXAM (Kindergarten, 2nd Grade, 6th Grade)

A dental exam is required for all students entering Kindergarten, 2nd and 6th Grade and is to be returned to the school office as soon as it has been completed by your child's dentist.

EYE EXAM (Kindergarten, new students to IL)

Effective January 1, 2008 Illinois passed a law requiring a comprehensive eye exam for children entering kindergarten or enrolling for *the first time in public, private, or parochial elementary schools in Illinois*. This exam needs to be completed by Oct. 15th.

ATHLETIC PERMISSION FORMS must be completed in Grades 5-8 PRIOR to student participation in any competitive sport (including practices and games). Any student involved in extramural activities MUST have a PRE-PARTICIPATION EXAMINATION FORM signed by both parents and DOCTOR.

Students in grade 6 may use their physical examination form as long as the INTERSCHOLASTIC SPORTS section is completed by the physician.
