Dear Members of Trinity,

If you are like me, your email box has been flooded by communications from companies detailing their response to the coronavirus. The challenge that this outbreak represents to you, to your family, friends and community, and to your church is likely not similar to anything you have seen before. All of us currently find ourselves having to process our way through uncertainty, understandable anxiety and heightened risk. At some point though, hopefully sooner rather than later, the world will return to normal. Throughout history, our church has always risen to meet whatever challenges have been thrown our way- usually emerging stronger than ever.

What is most important is that you stay safe and healthy. To that end, outlined below is what Trinity is doing to help ensure we follow government guidelines as well as keep you connected.

- The church office will be open every weekday from 9am-3pm if you should have any questions or need assistance in some way.
- The sanctuary will be open for those members who wish to come and pray during the week from 9am-3pm as well.
- We will not have any worship services for the next two weeks. This includes Wednesday mid-week Lenten services. (March 18th through March 29th).
- We will be Live Streaming a church service on Sunday, March 22nd and Sunday, March 29th. There will be a traditional service live-streamed at 9:30am and a contemporary service at 11:00am. If you go to Trinity's Facebook page you will have the ability to "click" on the live feed button and view the service. There will also be the opportunity to see who else is viewing the service and make comments.
- Both services will be available later in the day to view on Facebook, YouTube, and a link found in the Constant Contact message you received if you have opted to receive Constant Contact messages from Trinity in the past.
- Several groups will continue to meet at the church over the next two weeks. They are as follows:
 - Tuesday Bible Study 7pm (March 24th)
 - Wednesday Bible Study 12pm (March 25th)
 - Wednesday Night Men's Group 7pm (March 25th)
 - Saturday Morning Men's Group (March 21st)
- Most other groups plan to reconvene the week of March 30th and we will keep you update via our website. You can also call the church office if you have a question.
