

HOT LUNCH PROGRAMS

Trinity Lutheran School offers two different hot lunch programs. Listed below is a description of each program.

Tuesday Fundraiser Lunches

Lunches on Tuesday will alternate between McDonald's, Beggars Pizza and a hot dog lunch. McDonald's lunches help the 8th graders raise money for their class trip. The hot dog lunches are split between 5th, 7th and 8th grades for their class trips and Beggars Pizza goes towards our athletic booster club.

Tuesday Fundraiser lunches will be ordered on RenWeb. Orders must be placed for the full month by a set due date prior to the month of lunches. You may also order for several months ahead of time.

The charges will be added to your FACTS account. Please note there is a service fee for the use of a credit card. If you use a bank account, there will be no service fee.

My Hot Lunchbox orders are offered on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. Orders must be placed by noon the day before the lunch will be served. Lunches can also be canceled by noon on the day before the lunch will be served. In August, we will update our calendar of lunch providers. Previously we've had Panera, Panda Express, Potbelly, and Aurelios.
