REGISTRATION

You will be able to register for Sunday School on-line starting 8/29, at Friendship Sunday 9/11, or at the table by the music room the first day of Sunday School 9/18.

SUNDAY SCHOOL START DATE 9/18

Sunday School is from 9:30am -10:30am and will start on 9/18. Reveal Kids will begin on 9/18 as well for 5yr old's thru 9yr old's.

PK3 & PK4 age children will be in the gym. Classrooms for grades K-5th will be found in the north hallway of the school. Reveal Kids starts in the sanctuary at the 11am service and the kids are then dismissed to the music room prior to the beginning of the sermon. Reveal kids will return to sit with their parents in the sanctuary after the sermon.

Trinity Kids Preschool

Preschool Sunday School will continue this Year with a curriculum called Frolic. Frolic is a play-based curriculum that helps young children experience Bible stories in a meaningful and memorable way. Repetition is an important part of learning during early childhood and that is why each story has two weeks of lessons so children can revisit each story and go deeper.







Kindergarten through 5th & Reveal Kids 5-9 yr. old's

The Kindergartner's through 5th graders will continue for the second year with a curriculum called Holy Moly. This is a curriculum that uses creative and visual storytelling to enhance the learning experience. Children participate in the story and engaged in answering questions about the story and how the story may apply to their lives. Each week has a little different activity to keep things interesting. Some weeks children do crafts, some weeks they sing songs that relate back to the story, and some weeks they engage in Bible trivia related to the weekly story.

The Sunday School and Reveal Kids program is always in need of teachers.

Here is what you **DON'T** need in order to be a Sunday School teacher:

- You don't need to know the Bible inside and out
- You don't need teaching experience
- You don't need to teach every week
- You don't need to spend hours every week trying to prepare for a lesson
- You don't need to come up with a craft or materials for a craft every week

Here is what you **<u>DO</u>** need in order to be a Sunday School or Reveal Kids Teacher:

- You **do** need to want to enhance the spiritual life of our Trinity children
- You do need to want to spend about 15 minutes a week to look over the lesson provided to you
- You **do** need to have a heart for children
- You **do** need to be prepared for the rewarding feeling you will get when these kids are learning about Jesus
- You do need to be prepared for the bond you and the children will experience throughout the year sharing stories about Jesus
- You do need to have fun

All lessons and crafts are prepared well in advance. Currently, the lessons through the end of December are available in a binder in the music room. All crafts are prepared and can be found in a plastic bag with the date marked on them in the music room as well.

We are so excited that there will be a Sunday School Christmas program this year. The program will be held on Saturday, December 17th during the 6pm service.

There will be 3 practices for the Christmas program. The first practice will be on **12/4** during Sunday school at 9:30am. The second practice will be on **12/11** during Sunday school at 9:30am. The third and final practice will be the day of the program **(12/17) from 10am-11am**. This will be a dress rehearsal for the evening performance at 6pm.

Any Reveal Kids who would like to participate in the Christmas program are welcome to do so. We would LOVE for them to participate. We ask that they join the 9:30am Sunday school for practice on 12/4 and 12/11 and also attend the dress rehearsal the morning of the 17th from 10am-11am.

Preschool children will be involved in the Christmas performance too. We will practice with the 3yr and 4yr old's in the gym on 12/4 during Sunday school at 9:30am. The next practice will be on 12/11 during Sunday school at 9:30am. The third and final practice will be the day of the program (12/17) from 10am-11am. The preschool children will begin the program by singing two songs. They will then be allowed to go back and sit with their families for the rest of the performance.

Children will be expected to arrive at 5pm the evening of the 17th in order to be dressed and ready to go for the 6pm performance.

We will have cookies and beverages following the evening performance.
